

Simpson College Math Club Constitution

Article I: Name and Purpose

The name of the organization shall be the Math Club. Its purpose is to promote mathematical interest and discussion among members and within the Simpson community.

Article II: Meetings

The Math Club will hold meetings on Wednesdays at 7pm in Carver 340, as announced.

Article III: Membership

Section I: Membership is open to all Simpson College students. To be considered a member, one must regularly participate in math club meetings and activities.

Section II: Members of the Math Club will adhere to the Simpson College Code of Student Conduct. Those who do not will lose membership privileges.

Article IV: Officers and Advisor

Section I: There are four executive positions--President, Vice President of Public Relations, Vice President of Activities and Secretary. The President is responsible for presiding over the meetings, inviting speakers, and other general organization responsibilities. The Vice President of Public Relations is responsible for public relations, updating the constitution, and collaborating with the president on club activities. The Vice President of Activities is responsible for planning all Math Club events and details related to such events. The Secretary is responsible for taking minutes at meetings, sending minutes to members, updating the membership roster, as well as for submitting a budget to the Student Government Association annually. All executive positions must be filled by undergraduates.

Section II: The advisor must be a faculty member and is responsible for maintenance of the Math Club webpage as well as serving as a general resource for the club.

Article V: Operations

Elections will occur in the first meeting of the fall semester and be in effect for the full academic year. Subsequent elections may be held later in the year to fill open offices if needed. During the fall elections, members may be nominated or volunteer for an office. A simple majority of members is required to vote on any election or club matter. All members are eligible for office and must be present to vote.

Article VI: Finances

The Secretary will submit a budget annually to the SGA.

Article VII: Amendments

Amendments to the constitution may be discussed and proposed by the executive officers. They will be announced to members via e-mail or paper form before the next scheduled meeting so that they might be voted upon in said meeting.

Article VIII: Records and Registration

The Math Club will update its roster of active members and electronic list serve to reflect the most current membership records. Additionally, the Math Club will register with SGA as a student organization every fall.
